What is a Perinatal Volunteer Support

Someone to support within our peer groups (called Mindful Mums) in March and Chatteris. The groups run once a month and a perinatal volunteer supports our facilitator by welcoming mums, making drinks, supporting conversations, occupying children in the room. This enables mums to feel relaxed and able to talk without the distractions.

- Attending online zoom induction with Peer and Volunteer Manager along with completion of online training
- Additional training will be offered when it becomes available and if appropriate.
